Job Specification

Overview:

The purpose of Information & IT Security is ensuring ING will be amongst the safest banks and will be seen as a leader in (IT) security. We assist Wholesale Banking (WB) including the Tech organisation Globally in being successful in IT Risk and IT Security. Overall, we ensure that IT Risk Management and IT Security is part of our DNA.

The Chief Information Security Office (CISO)/IT Security squads have a split reporting line to UK CAO/WB CISO & UK CIO. The squad functions are responsible for UK Anti-Fraud, Business Continuity, Disaster Recovery, 1st Line of Defence Security & Risk Management activities of UK Region and management of Information Security & Risk associated with all technology assets used by ING UK (London) and our office in Dubai.

The squad functionally reports into WB Global CISO office & WB Network & Core Banking - IT Security tribe.

The squads are responsible for ensuring that the ING Group Security Policies are implemented in the businesses within its remit. These include risk assessments for applications and projects, Security Monitoring, Vulnerability Management, Security Incident Management and IT SOX Compliance etc. The CISO & IT Security teams work in an agile framework.

Main Duties and Responsibilities of Role

- Member of the WB UK CISO & IT Security Team.
- Assist in Application Security Reviews using CISO Risk tooling (i.e./ 3rd party / Cloud provider assessments).
- Assist in Creating and reviewing Security Baseline Documents.
- Asssit with providing monthly data input for KRIs submission for 2nd Line IRM and IT Security.
- Collaborating with Global Centre of Excellence Key Control Testing teams, to provide input and assist with key control testing for IT generic controls.
- Assist with the review vulnerability reports, providing consultation to IT Dev Ops squads for resolution.



- Assist colleagues with ongoing Security Awareness Training towards all staff
- Assist and contribute ideas with CISO/IT Security small & medium sized projects.
- Assist colleagues with the review of Data Leakage reports and follow up with unusual activity.
- Provide assistance and guidance with phishing and malware incidents.
- Working with an agile approach as part of the ING One Agile Way of Working framework.
- Assisting the WB UK CISO office completing their quarterly business reviews (QBR) activities, e.g. reporting Anti-Fraud incidents, collaborating with the business in Business Continuity and Operational Resilience.
- Working with the rest of the interns to put together 'meet the manager' sessions amongst the managers, networking events and product sessions.
- Thinking of ideas for charity events for the London office and taking them on and making them happen!
